## **NEW GARBAGE CARTS**

The 96 gallon cart is provided to you by Progressive Waste Solutions along with St. Landry Parish Solid Waste. The cart is to be used solely for garbage collection. On collection days place the cart on a flat surface, with the arrow on the lid of the cart pointing toward the street. We ask that all household garbage items be placed inside the container. Garbage items should be bagged and tied, and then placed in your cart. Please don't load your carts with: hot ashes or charcoal, flammable items, household hazardous waste, paint, construction debris, dirt, bricks or concrete, tires, automotive batteries, motor oil, loose grass, leaves or branches.
